

Deanpark Primary School responses in Questionnaire

Summary of Key Themes

1. Building Condition & Modernisation (Very Strong Theme)

- Many describe the school as “**dated**”, “**run down**”, or “**past its use years.**”
- Frequent calls for:
 - Full **rebuild** (not just partial upgrades)
 - Removal of **portacabins**
 - General **modernisation and refurbishment**
- Positive sentiment toward the **new annex**, but concern the main building lags behind.

👉 Overall: Strong perception the **core estate is no longer fit for modern learning.**

2. Capacity & Population Growth

- Repeated concerns about:
 - **Rising population** (new housing developments)
 - **Overcrowding / lack of space**
- Suggestions include:
 - **Second primary school**
 - Expansion of current site
 - Flexible or phased development

👉 Overall: चिंता that infrastructure has **not kept pace with housing growth.**

3. Traffic, Parking & Safety (Dominant Issue)

- This is one of the **most frequently mentioned and emotionally charged topics.**
- Issues raised:
 - Dangerous parking (pavements, junctions, double parking)
 - Congestion at drop-off/pick-up

- Conflict with residents
- Unsafe walking conditions
- Suggested fixes:
 - Better **drop-off zones**
 - **Traffic enforcement / wardens**
 - **Car-free zones**
 - Improved **walking & cycling routes**

👉 Overall: Seen as a **serious safety issue**, not just inconvenience.

4. Outdoor Space & Play Facilities

- Requests for:
 - Better **playgrounds and equipment**
 - Improved **drainage (muddy fields)**
 - More **green space / outdoor learning areas**
 - All-weather surfaces (e.g., Astro)

👉 Overall: Outdoor provision is valued but seen as **underdeveloped or poorly maintained**.

5. Community & Extended Use

- Interest in:
 - **Community access** (evenings/weekends)
 - Schools as **local hubs**
- Some ideas for:
 - Co-located services (e.g., health, community use)

👉 Overall: Appetite for **multi-use, community-integrated schools**.

6. Support for Staff & Pupils

- Concerns about:

- **Teacher workload**
- Need for **more support staff**
- Better provision for:
 - **ASN (Additional Support Needs)**
 - Quiet/sensory spaces
- Calls for:
 - Smaller class sizes
 - Improved facilities for inclusion

👉 Overall: Strong support for staff, but recognition system is **under pressure**.

7. Childcare & Flexibility

- Requests for:
 - **Earlier breakfast clubs**
 - **Later after-school care**
 - More **after-school activities**

👉 Overall: Reflects needs of **working families**.

8. Mixed / Neutral Responses

- Some respondents:
 - Had **no direct experience**
 - Felt the school is already **good/excellent**

👉 Overall: While criticism is strong, there is also **baseline goodwill toward the school**.

Proposals (Grouped & Actionable)

A. Strategic Infrastructure Plan

1. **Full Estate Review (Short-term priority)**
 - Independent assessment of:

- Building condition
 - Capacity vs projected population
 - Output: decision between **full rebuild vs phased redevelopment**
2. **Plan for a Second Primary School (Medium–Long term)**
- Especially near **new housing developments (e.g., north of Lanark Road)**
 - Reduces:
 - Overcrowding
 - Traffic concentration
3. **Phased Redevelopment Model**
- Expand new annex gradually
 - Retire old buildings in stages
 - Avoid disruption to learning

B. Traffic & Safety Overhaul (High Priority)

1. **School Streets Scheme**
- Temporary **car-free zone at drop-off/pick-up times**
 - Proven in many UK areas
2. **Dedicated Drop-off Hub (“Park & Stride”)**
- Identify nearby car parks
 - Encourage walking last 5–10 minutes
3. **Active Travel Infrastructure**
- Safe:
 - Walking routes
 - Cycle paths
 - Crossings
 - Add **lollipop staff / wardens**
4. **Enforcement**
- Regular patrols or camera enforcement

- Clear penalties for unsafe parking

C. Outdoor & Learning Environment

1. Playground Upgrade Programme

- All-weather surfaces
- Modern play equipment
- Inclusive design

2. Field Drainage / Astro Pitch

- Solve unusable muddy field issue

3. Outdoor Learning Spaces

- Forest-school style areas
 - Covered outdoor classrooms

D. Modern Learning Environment

1. Design for 2040 Learning

- Flexible classrooms
- Quiet/sensory rooms
- Digital + non-digital balance

2. Net-Zero / Eco School Concept

- Solar panels, green roofs
 - Modular expansion capability

E. Family & Community Support

1. Extended School Hours

- Earlier breakfast clubs
- Later after-school provision

2. More After-School Activities

- Sports, arts, clubs

3. **Community Use Model**

- Open facilities evenings/weekends
 - Potential co-location with:
 - Health services
 - Community groups

F. Staffing & Inclusion

1. **Increase Support Staff**

- Classroom assistants
- ASN specialists

2. **Dedicated ASN Facilities**

- Quiet rooms
- Sensory spaces

3. **Teacher Workload Reduction**

- Admin support
 - Better resource provision
